AIS is 10 minute walk from Hoshigaoka subway station in central Nagoya.



School Overview

AIS consists of a kindergarten and an elementary school. The kindergarten program is completely in English. Students follow a curriculum based on the province of British Columbia, using resources and texts from overseas.

At elementary school Japanese speaking students follow a bilingual program of English (again based on the British Columbia curriculum) and Japanese using MEXT guidelines). Non-Japanese speaking students study the same English program, with the opportunity to take JASL (Japanese as a second language) classes twice a week, to learn basic Japanese language skills and learn about Japanese society and culture.

AIS is a WASC (Western Association of Schools and Colleges) accredited school. All of the teachers have teaching qualifications from their home countries, and there are a range of after-school classes including Art, soccer and Chinese clubs.
